OPENER

LEADER: "Hi, everyone! It's another day of game show fun here at [name of your environment]! You helped me pick out this snazzy game show host outfit last time, and I must say, it was the best choice you could have made.

"We're playing games and making choices all month long . . . and if this outfit gives any clue to the choices you'll make, we're in good shape!

"Today we'll play a game I like to call 'Friendly Feud'! Let's start out by dividing into two teams.

Divide the kids into two teams, making sure to divide ages as equally as possible.

"You now have 10 seconds to pick your team name and choose a team captain.

Count down in your head, and then hit the buzzer when the time is up.

"Let's hear those team names!

Draw a line down the middle of the dry-erase board. Write the team names on one side of the board. This is where you'll keep track of their points.

On the other half of the board (or on a separate board), write the numbers 1 through 5. This is where you'll write down the correct answers as the kids guess them.

"Let's have our team captains come up and kick us off.

Bring up the two captains. Have them stand on opposite sides of the stool/table with the buzzer.

(To the captains) "[Kids' names], please stand on either side of this buzzer. Put one hand behind your back. I'll ask you a question that has five possible answers. When I ask you the question, if you're the first person to hit the buzzer, you get to give me an answer. If you guess one of the five possible answers on the board, you'll score one point for your team.

"However, you'd better think before you speak—or even hit the buzzer! Because if your answer is NOT on the board (make an X with your arms and make a strike noise) . . . or if you don't have an answer immediately, the other captain will get a chance to answer.

"After our captains have had a turn and one team has scored a point, then play will go to the OTHER team. They'll try to guess another one of the answers together as a team. We'll keep going back and forth, and the team with the most points at the end of the game wins.

"Let's play 'Friendly Feud'! Our game today will be focused on this question. Remember, captains—hit the buzzer as soon as you have a guess.

Read from the printed "Friendly Feud" Game Sheet.

"Name one of the top five kid-friendly movies worldwide in 2023.

Call on the team captain who hits the buzzer first. If they don't answer within five seconds, allow the other team captain a chance to guess. Use the Game Sheet to reference which answers are correct.

Give a point to the team whose captain successfully guesses one of the five answers on the board. Write their correct answer on the board (next to the appropriate number).

Note: If neither captain guesses correctly, then go back to the first team and let them make a guess as a team, and so on.

After the first round with the captains, the rest of the game will be played as a team. When it's their turn, the team will work together to choose a guess, and the captain will give you their guess. If they answer correctly, give them a point and write their answer on the board (next to the appropriate number).

Anytime a team guesses a movie that is NOT on the list, the Leader will make an X with their arms and make a strike sound. That team does not get a point, and the next turn goes back to the other team.

Keep bouncing back and forth between the teams until they've guessed all five answers (or as long as time allows). You can give a hint if needed, but make sure to give the other team a hint for the next question in order to keep the game fair.

LEADER: "Before we sing, let's all read this month's Memory Verse together. It's 2 Peter 1:3a.

SLIDE: MEMORY VERSE

LEADER AND KIDS: God's power has given us everything we need to lead a godly life. (2 Peter 1:3a, NIrV)

LEADER: "It's so good to know that we don't have to rely on our own strength to choose to do what's best. God gives us the power to **[Basic Truth]** make the wise choice. Let's worship now and thank God for giving us everything we need to have self-control!

AUDIO: "THE POWER" / TRACK 3 FROM EVERYTHING TO ME

"Even when we feel weak, God's strength is at work in us. God's Spirit helps us choose what's best. We can move when we know God wants us to move . . . and we can wait when God wants us to wait. Let's sing about that now.

AUDIO: "KEEP ON WAITING" / TRACK 4 FROM MY LIFE FOR YOU

"Great singing, everyone! That was fun. You can have a seat."

BIBLE STORY

SLIDE: THEME BACKGROUND

SETTING UP THE STORY

LEADER: "Today we're reading from the book of Proverbs in the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) Proverbs is a collection of wise sayings—many of which came from King Solomon.

"You might remember how Solomon became king over God's people when he was young. He was worried about leading an entire nation with so little experience. One night, God spoke to Solomon in a dream and told him that he could have ANY gift he wanted.

"Solomon could have asked for money or power, but what did he ask for? (*Pause for response*.) Right. Wisdom. Solomon knew that he needed God's wisdom so he could be the best leader for his people. And sure enough, God made Solomon one of the wisest people who ever lived!

"Many of the things Solomon learned and said were collected here in the book of Proverbs. (Hold up Bible.) These sayings, or proverbs, can help us make wise decisions in our everyday lives.

WORDS ARE POWERFUL

LEADER: "Listen to Solomon's wise words here in Proverbs 12:18.

Open the Bible to Proverbs 12:18 (NIrV) and read.

The words of thoughtless people cut like swords.

But the tongue of wise people brings healing. (NIrV)

"Let me read that again.

The words of thoughtless people cut like swords.

But the tongue of wise people brings healing. (NIrV)

Walk behind the table with the printed pictures that are pre-taped to the front edge, facing down on the tabletop.

"Okay. Have you ever thought about how powerful your words can be? Words are like a superpower that God has given us.

"Our words can be SO powerful that they're like swords.

Flip the sword picture (#1) over the side of the table so the kids can see it.

"If we're not careful, our words can do a lot of damage. They can hurt someone deeply.

"Or . . . our words can help someone heal.

Flip the bandage picture (#2) over the side of the table so the kids can see it.

STOP AND THINK

LEADER: "Remember, Solomon said:

Open the Bible to Proverbs 12:18 (NIrV) and read.

The words of **thoughtless** people cut like swords. (NIrV)

"'Thoughtless' means that we don't think. We just say whatever comes to mind. And that can get us into trouble!

"See, we don't usually mean to hurt others with our words. But we just don't think first. We don't stop to consider how our words will come across to the other person.

"So what can you do to avoid hurting someone with your words? Before you speak, STOP.

Flip the stop sign picture (#3) over the side of the table so the kids can see it.

"Once you stop, take a second to THINK.

Flip the thought bubble picture (#4) over the side of the table so the kids can see it.

"If what you're about to say is mean or hurtful . . . don't say it!

WORDS THAT HEAL

LEADER: "Instead, you could choose words that HEAL.

Point back to the picture with the bandage (#2).

"Remember what Solomon said?

Open the Bible to Proverbs 12:18 (NIrV) and read.

The tongue of wise people brings healing. (NIrV)

"What type of words can do that? What types of words bring healing?

Ask the kids for suggestions. Match their suggestions to these categories, and flip over the pictures as you reference them:

- Words of love (heart picture, #5)
- Encouraging words (thumbs-up picture, #6)
- Words of truth (Bible picture, #7)

"Right. We can speak words of love. We can let people know that we care about them, and that we've always got their back.

"We can speak encouraging words. We can give a compliment, or let someone know that we're glad they're our friend.

"We can speak words of truth. We can remind each other of what's true about God—that God loves us, and God is always with us. We can even share verses from the Bible that will help someone remember that God is there.

"It's important to stop and think BEFORE you say something. That way you can avoid saying thoughtless words that hurt.

Point back to the picture with the sword (#1).

"You can make sure that your words are helpful and healing.

Point back to the picture with the bandage (#2).

"And if you THINK something positive about someone, take a few seconds to actually SAY it!

Walk in front of the table as you wrap up.

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

LEADER: "It's not easy to control what you say . . . especially if you try to do it on your own. We all need God's help so we can choose our words carefully.

"That's why it's so important for us to stop and think about what we say . . . before we say it. We can pray in those moments and ask God to help us. When we follow Jesus, God sends the Holy Spirit to live inside of us and give us quidance. God's Spirit can help us control the things we say so our words bring healing instead of hurt.

"Here's what we need to remember today:

SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

"Think before you speak. Say that with me."

LEADER AND KIDS: "Think before you speak."

"I bet we can all think of some times when other people's words hurt us. We can also probably think of times when we've hurt someone with OUR words—even if we didn't mean to. Sometimes we speak harsh words out of anger. Or maybe we say something that's supposed to be a joke . . . but it ends up hurting someone's feelings.

"I bet we can also think of times when someone shared healing words with us-words that really helped us.

Share about a time when someone spoke words of love, encouragement, or truth to you and made a difference in your life.

"I know I want to use healing words like that with the people around me. That takes a lot of self-control! It means taking a second to stop and think . . . and ask God for help. Like if your little brother spills water all over your homework . . . you could take a deep breath and tell him it's okay, because you know it was an accident. Or if your friend is having a bad day, you can encourage them and let them know that you're always there to talk. Sometimes it's wisest not to say anything at all . . . and just listen.

"God's Spirit creates self-control IN us. That's what gives us the strength to choose our words with kindness and compassion. Let's pray and ask God to help us use our words wisely!"

PRAYER

LEADER: "Dear God, we want to practice self-control—especially when it comes to our words. We want to be thoughtful and choose words that are healing, not hurtful. Please help each of us in here to slow down . . . to pause . . . and to think about the words that we're saying to others. Please help us to choose words that heal so we can show Your love to people around us. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

Dismiss kids to their small groups.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Download the slides and have them ready to use. If you do not have screen capabilities, you have Orange's permission to enlarge and print the slides on paper.
- Confirm that your church has appropriate licensing to perform or play music and sound effects in your kids' environments (see above under Opener).
- Place the table(s) on the stage. Tape each of the printed Bible Story Pictures onto the table(s), onto the edge that's facing the audience. The top edge of each page should be flush with the tabletop as you tape it. Make sure the pages are in the correct order from the script (starting with #1 on the left, going toward #7 on the right), from the audience's perspective, spaced evenly. Once the pages are secure, flip them up and over so that they're lying flat on the tabletop with the printed side down. As the Leader tells the story, they'll flip over the pictures so the kids can see them, one by one.
